## NCA AGREEMENTS WITH THE NORWEGIAN MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (MFA)

NCA's four-year <u>Strategic Partnership Agreement (SPA) with the MFA</u> is entitled *NCA Saves Lives, Alleviates Suffering and Protects Human Dignity*. The SPA is valid from January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2023. The financial frame for the SPA is NOK 840 000 000 over the four years, with an annual frame of NOK 210 000 000.

Twelve countries are included in the SPA: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, DRC, Iraq, Lebanon, Mali, Nigeria, Palestine, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan and Syria. Five countries, Lebanon, Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan and Syria, are included for the entire agreement period. Six global projects are also included and focus on six areas: Capacity and Response; Coordination and Advocacy; WASH; GBV; ASRH; and Protection.
