CARE Norway invites you to a global seminar on how to better engage men for women's rights and gender equality.

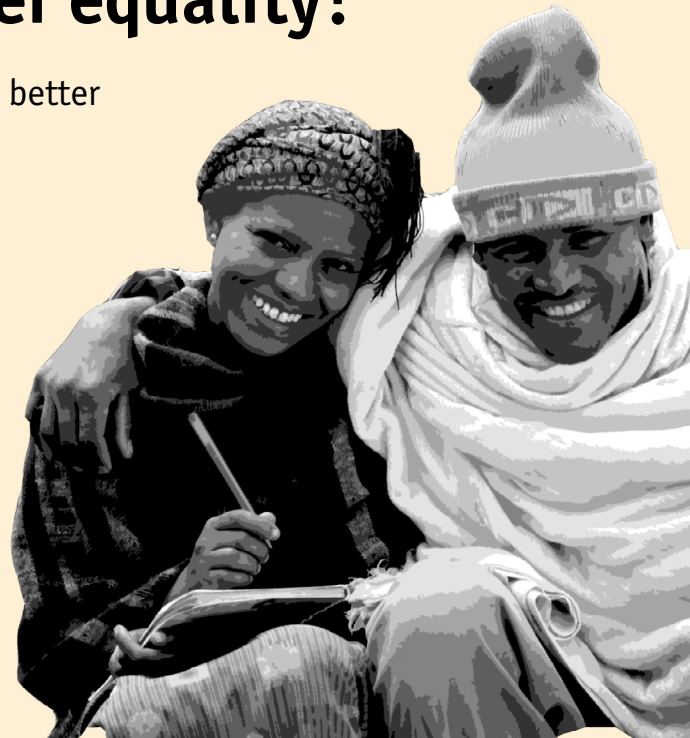
